We invite boys and girls and young adults to play golf at Royal Perth Golf Club. Junior programmes and special membership opportunities are available up to the age of 29.



Beginners

- RPGC welcomes beginner golfers to attend coaching clinics at the club. Our Pro Shop staff offer a junior clinic for boys and girls every Sunday morning at 9.30 for all levels of player. Individual lessons are also available. Contact the Pro Shop directly on 9367 1666 for prices and availability.
- A Girl's Club clinic is held for girls aged 7-15 on Tuesday afternoon at 4.30pm. Coaching by the Club Professional and a variety of skills games and fun activities are offered. Registration is essential. RPGC is a registered MyGolf centre.
- Progress to play on the course requires an application for membership of RPGC which will be followed by an assessment by the Club Professional. Full details will be provided at a membership interview.

Restricted Junior (Ages up to 18)

- This category is designed to help young, keen beginners improve their skills and transition to full Junior Membership when ready.
- You will have access to the course after 3.30pm every day, subject to the course being open and are eligible to play in all Junior Club events.
- We aim to support and teach you the skills required to obtain a handicap, understand course management and learn course etiquette.
- With the help of our Junior Clinics and Club volunteers we hope to teach you all the basics required to become a competent Club golfer.

Junior Member (Ages up to 18)

- Once you have obtained a registered Golfink handicap of 35 or less for boys or 44 or less for girls, and have met our standards of course etiquette, you will be eligible to join as a Junior member.
- As a Junior you have full playing rights and will have access to all member competitions, not just Junior events.
- You may also be selected to play in the Pennant Team.
- Individual coaching may be provided by the Club for Members who show enthusiasm and promise.
